The Weatherization Assistance Program helps reduce energy costs for low-income households (see maximum income guidelines below) by increasing the energy efficiency of their homes, while ensuring their health and safety. All weatherization work is done at no cost to the individual resident.

General eligibility criteria for the Weatherization Assistance Program includes —

- Applicant must own the property they are applying for.
- Property Owner's household annual gross income must be less than 80% area median income. Must be located within the boundaries of Saline County, KS. (address cannot be a PO Box or an address that leads to a shipping center as their physical location).
